Jaguar XK-150 Drives Again After 40 Years Jeff Simpson

When we bought the car 36 years ago with the intention of using it as a father-son project, it was pretty forlorn. While we worked on it off and on over the years, the real work had to wait until I retired. With the encouragement of my wife, son, and friends, the restoration went from "This will never get done" to "Well maybe" then "How about a ride around the block!" I did most of the work myself, learning that I was usually dissatisfied with work I paid others to do. I certainly learned a lot along the way, not just about old Jaguars but planning, expectations, costs, and the value of very helpful friends and family.



We finally decided to take the car on a extended shake-down cruise

even though there was still work to be done. The short drives around town led me to think it was ready to go, but there is nothing like a real road trip to identify what still needs sorting out. The plan was to attend the British Car Days event in Los Cruses, New Mexico, with an overnight stop in Bisbee on the way there and in Silver City on the return to Tucson.

We started out from Tucson with a group of friends in four other British cars. After about fifty miles of highway driving, the temperature gauge started creeping up and up until we couldn't ignore it and had to pull over. No coolant system leaks could be found. It seemed all the water loss was from the radiator overflow. So began a series of stops, waiting for the radiator to cool enough to open the cap and add water and go a little further. We did this over and over until we had used all the water our group had. While waiting for more water, just short of Bisbee, we called an auto repair shop to organize a new radiator cap. They managed to get a new cap by



the time we arrived. On testing the problem cap, we found it would hold zero psi. With the new cap in place, the temperature seemed, to hold so on we went to Los Cruces. It is amazing how such a simple part like a radiator cap, brand new, can cause so much trouble.

The Los Cruces British Car Days event turned out to be very well organized and well attended, with lots of great cars and people. At the awards breakfast on Sunday we were very surprised and pleased to receive "First in



Class" and the "Presidents Trophy".

The drive to Silver City was very scenic with twisting, turning and long straight sections and higher altitude. We began to get a feel for the car, and our confidence in it steadily improved. The XK-150 seemed to run better and better as we went along. The next morning, we returned to Tucson hoping to miss a possible dust storm. We got back into the garage with a long list of items to change, fix, or finish.

The trip in this car was a long, long, time in the making, but the car exceeded our expectations and we are looking forward to our next trip.

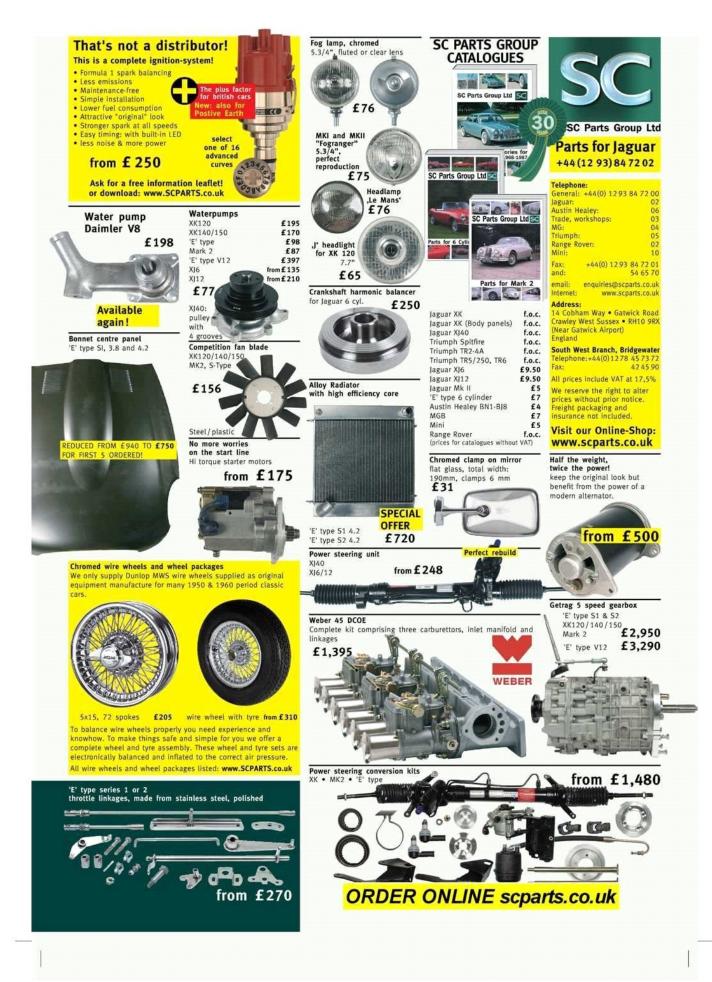
