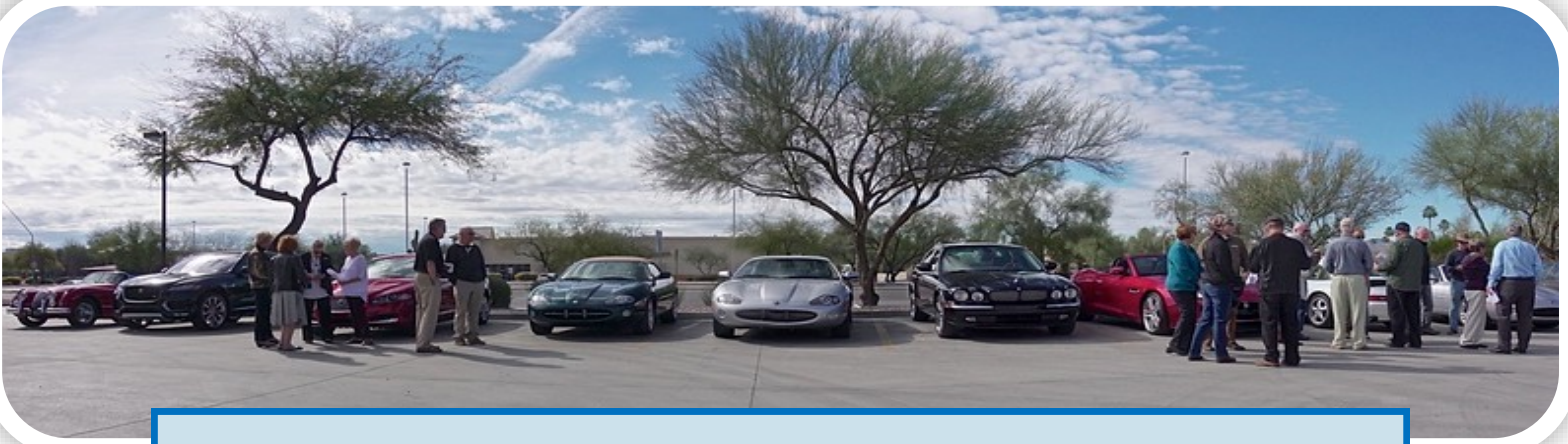

JCSA MEMBER SLIPS THE SURLY BONDS OF EARTH

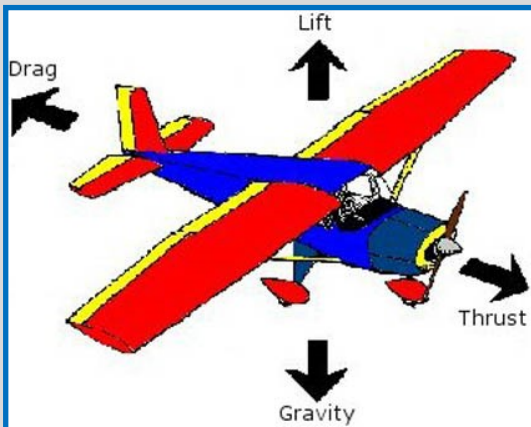

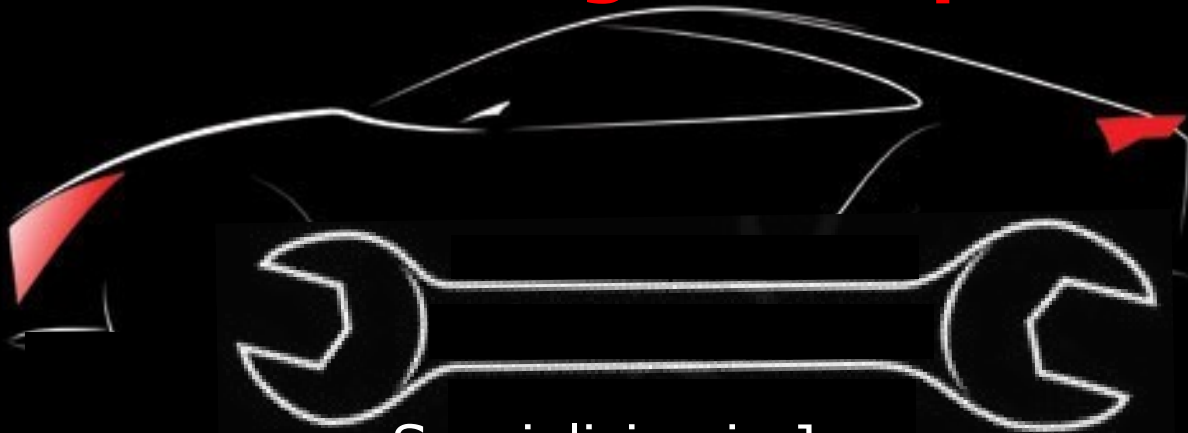

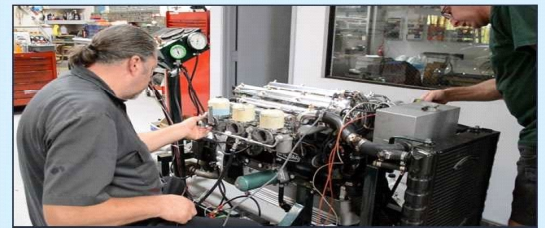
