The fun actually started on Saturday afternoon when we met up at the Jack in the Box on I10 and Ina for the convoy drive out to Pinal. Bill Badger organized this entire event and he led the convoy to the security gate where he cleared us through and onto the base.


A real nice aspect of this event is the fact that we can go out there the night before and stay overnight at the on-site motel. We took snacks and drinks and enjoyed socializing for a few hours before dinner which we were privileged to have in the mess hall of the Western ARNG Aviation Training Site.

On Sunday morning we were up early for another trip over to the mess hall for an excellent slap up breakfast then it was out to the track to set up for the high performance driving. We were pleasantly surprised to find that two new ramadas had been built which saved us the need to erect the canopies we had brought. We laid traffic cones where necessary, did tech checks on the cars, signed waiver forms, drank some water, got the helmets out of the boxes and finally were ready for the safety briefing by Bill. The main focus of Bill's briefing was safety of course but the track is very safe with no obstacles to concern drivers so the whole driving experience is very enjoyable indeed. We were very few cars so there was no need to have more than one car on the track at the same time. Each session consisted of 3 laps with the last lap being timed, not from a competitive point of view, just for the information of drivers. So we continued through the morning taking as many 3 lap sessions as each driver wanted and by noon we were done, packed up and on our way home after an exhilarating morning enjoying our cars in a way which is not possible on normal roads. Once again our thanks go to Bill Badger for all the work he put into organizing this fun event.
