

President's Message

all has arrived (at least in most places in the country). Snowbirds are returning and we're gearing up for our main event, our Concours d'Elegance. We have some exciting additions this year to our Concours and I encourage you to participate. If you are not entering your beautiful Cat for the event, I'd still like to encourage you to come out and take a look and enjoy the beautiful display of all of these fine automobiles.

Our other main focus as fall arrives is developing the ballot for nominations for next year's Board of Directors. Voting will be in late November with the results announced at the Holiday Party in December. While this has been a year of learning (and boy am I glad I can still learn something at this age) and enjoyment, I will not be continuing on the Board next year (other than as Advisory Board). I have family obligations to tend to and my plate has been running over for the past several months. I have met a very fine group of people during this year and am delighted to have made new acquaintances, but now it's time for someone else to sit in the driver's seat.

JCSA faces some ongoing challenges and one of the main ones is getting people to take an active roll in the club. Club officers participate on the Board and keep the club moving forward, but it is your organization and your involvement is vital for keeping the club alive. Not only do we need a new President for next year, we also need at least one and preferably two or three people to work on planning and executing our events. Please consider being an active member through your involvement as an officer or event chair for next year.

I've been keeping a tally this year of membership participation for our dinners and events. The results are interesting and bear consideration as we plan for next year. As of September 15, 2013 we have 56 members. (This figure takes into consideration the fact that we tend to lose a few members at the beginning of the year and then gain some back during the year.) Based on memberships, not total number of people, 25% of the membership participates in

the First Wednesday dinners while only 15% participate in other events. 7% of our membership lives out of the local area, but of those that live in the local area, 25% have not participated in either the events or dinners. Clearly our membership likes to socialize and one thing I have noticed, if there's food at the end of the event, the participation goes up. The future Board will want to consider these statistics as they plan for future club events. What are your thoughts? Do we move more toward drives around the local area for lunches and/or dinners? Your thoughts will help the club continue to serve the interests of the membership.

No matter which direction we go, we still need your help, so if you have yet to sit in one of our board seats and you have the time, I encourage you to come forward and help keep this fine club going. As a reminder a membership includes both spouses and we would welcome anyone's participation.

Our theme at this year's Concours is "Art of the Jaguar." We have three local artists that will be joining us and displaying their fine works of art that are jaguar related.

Pam Cheeseman specializes in watercolors. Her subjects are usually wildlife, mostly animals and flowers. However, she has also done portraits and landscapes. She has done a beautiful piece of artwork of a jaguar (animal) that she will have on display with some of her other fine works.

Pam is a Signature Member of the Southern Arizona Watercolor Guild and a juried member of the Southern Arizona Watercolor Guild. She has juried and exhibited in shows for several years now and has won numerous awards.

Marty Plevel also specializes in watercolors. She found her niche in painting which she calls her "Garage Series." I consigned Marty to do a watercolor of my Jaguar that I will have on display at the Concours. She is a very talented artist and also does portraits of people. She currently has her "Garage Series" on display through October 29th at the Mother Road Brewing Company in Flagstaff. If you are in the area, feel free to stop by and enjoy the "Garage Series."

Marty is a Signature Member of the Southern Arizona Watercolor Guild and a member of the Southern Arizona Arts Guild.

Marty has generously donated a watercolor titled "Spoken Four" which will also be on display at our Concours. This piece will be available for a raffle drawing to be held at our annual Holiday Party on December 7th. Anyone who joins JCSA, or any current JCSA member who renews their membership before the Holiday Party, is eligible for the drawing.

Lynn Anglin received a Fine Art Scholarship in Toronto, Canada in 1965. Her major was in sculpture and design. She studied extensive art history and painting with a protégé of Henry Moore and the late Doris McCarthy, renowned Canadian artist. After a 45-year hiatus from painting, she has begun painting again with a passion. Her work can best be described as Representational/Realism.

This year, Lynn generously donated a large work of art with vintage cars to the University of Arizona's Fresh Paint Fund Raiser. Among artists competing for top dollar through the silent and live auction events, Lynn's work was the top of the 5 major artists there. Some of her oils for sale at our *Concours* will be of jaguar automobiles and other vintage cars and trucks.

She is a member of the Southern Arizona Arts Guild and is also a member and exhibitor of the University of Arizona Museum of Art.
