

JAGUAR LAND ROVER OPENING NORTH AMERICAN CLASSIC CENTER

Opening next summer near Savannah, Georgia Jaguar Land Rover is planning to open a U.S. Classic Center near Savannah, Georgia, – its first such facility outside Europe. The company opened the U.K.-based Classic operation about a year ago.

The U.S. outfit will restore vintage Jags and Land Rovers out of production for 10 years or more. The 75,000-squre foot building will have 42 service bays and a sales showroom. The U.K. operation is roughly twice as big, has 54 bays and also focuses on restoring cars 10-plus years old. Savannah construction starts this fall.
