Back to the Future: Jaguar GT 2025

A lot has been written about Jaguar's new strategy. With the all-electric XJ canned at the eleventh hour to take stock of where Jaguar should be in today's automotive landscape, many have asked what's next for the famed British brand. But Jaguar Land Rover's (JRL) has confirmed some early details of the first all-new up-market Jaguar.

As depicted by purely speculative artists' rendering at this stage, the model will be an all-electric four-door GT. In addition to the as-yet-unnamed GT, Jaguar will also offer two more EVs based on the JEA platform, although details have not been forthcoming.

The first of the new-age Jaguars, the fruit of the ambitious Reimagine program, will have a range of up to 430 miles (700 km), with deliveries starting in 2025. It will sit on an all-new dedicated architecture, dubbed JEA (Jaguar Electric Architecture), and start at £100,000 (equivalent to around \$125,000 at current exchange rates).

Why Jaguar Is on a Mission to Trim Down Its U.S. Dealer Footprint

Jaguar dealers in the U.S. are beginning to experience a shift in offerings of new Jaguars from JLR. Jaguar wants to push aggressively upmarket by planning to compete with Bentley with a three-car lineup of all electric offerings priced higher than existing model beginning in 2025. With a smaller, pricier and more exclusive range planned, it will mean that Jaguar is forced to shrink its U.S. dealer network. Despite semi-conductor-related delays in fulfillment, JLR posted a profit in the latter half of 2022 which was led by new Range Rover models. At the moment, there are some 395 JLR dealerships in the U.S., with many of them offering both Jaguar and Land Rover products side by side.

On a related topic, JLR Rover has appointed the company's head of UK operations, Rawdon Glover, to oversee the revamped Jaguar brand. Glover's title will be "Brand Managing Director, Jaguar." His promotion comes as Jaguar prepares to become an all-electric brand in 2025 and position itself higher in the market with a new range of luxury models.




