The 45-minute tour of the Titan II, the last of 54 intercontinental ballistic missiles that were active between 1963 to 1987, provides a fascinating experience depicting the reality of the Cold War paranoia. Each tour is limited to 30 people and a reservation requires entrance fees to be paid when making your reservation. Please review the safety issues outlined on the Museum website indicating everyone must be able to safely descend and ascend 55 stairs. There is no elevator access to the underground silo. There are landings located every 8 steps to break up the descent/ascent. If a person does not want to take the missile tour, a free video is available to watch on the main floor.

Former *The Tonight Show* host and comedian Jay Leno and his team have undertaken some mammoth restorations, but this 1963 Jaguar XKE barn find may just be the pick of the bunch. It's a car that was in a cluttered garage in Burbank, California, and since then, his team has worked to get it back onto the road. Unlike other projects in the garage, this project was more about conservation, not restoration, and preserving its all-original nature. The conservation of the car took around a year to complete, with Leno and the team trying to keep as much of the car as original as they found it while cleaning it up and getting back on the road. It is safe to say that this is a mission accomplished as seen in this video.

F-Type V8 Engine Recording in the British Library

With Jaguar set to embark on an electric-only future that will render its new models almost silent, the iconic sounds of its burbling petrol engines will soon be lost. But nostalgic petrolheads will still be able to hear its last petrol-engine sports car's V8 motor at full song decades after the brand's decision to cut ties with combustion engines and from 2025 transition exclusively to electric vehicles (EVs).

Jaguar has shared high-quality sound recordings of its last petrol sports car, the V8 F-Type 75 R, with the British Library in London, where they will be archived for all time. The audio clips – made from inside the cabin and from outside the car – capture the rasping supercharged V8 in all its glory. The recordings were made inside a semi-anechoic chamber at the car maker's Gaydon Engineering Centre. This is a soundproof room used to develop and test the refinement and sound quality of Jaguar vehicles, and is where the F-Type's roaring V8 was originally tuned. The audio clips then capture a variety of the F-Type's vocal abilities as it gathers pace before the driver lifts off the throttle. Jaguar says: 'Each time the F-Type accelerates, the valves in the exhaust system open to alter the exhaust gas routing and this releases the signature roar that is particular to the F-Type driving experience.

"Listeners will hear the crisp upshifts and downshifts through the eight-speed Quickshift transmission, and the distinctive, hallmark crackles and pops on the overrun from its quad tailpipes, which are a key element of F-Type's visceral, driver-focused character." Charles Richardson, senior sound engineer at Jaguar, said: "The sounds you experience driving the F-Type is something we want to be available for generations to come."

Tina Turner's Beloved Jaguars

The late icon's Jaguar XJ6 and a Jaguar E-Type gave her a much-needed taste of freedom – and then she had to fight in Court to keep them. Tina Turner has passed away, leaving behind a cultural legacy. Her successful career and turbulent personal life have been well-documented. One of the lesser-known elements of Turner's personal life, however, was her passion for cars and driving – particularly her love for her two Jaguar cars. In her 2018 autobiography, she said that one of her favorite escapes and a secret pleasure was driving my Jaguar. "I loved it because it was something I could do by myself, one of the few times I could be alone and free." She briefly faced losing her cars in her 1978 divorce from Ike, which left her heavily in debt. The judge ruled in her favor, so she walked out of the courtroom "with just my name. 
