President's Message

We have some great events on our schedule over the next months. On March 16th we will hold an unsanctioned fun car rally. More info to come very soon. We also have a drive to Santa Fe scheduled for April 29th thru May 2nd. Both events will showcase our beautiful Jaguars.

Other events include a drive and lunch to Agua Caliente Park, drive and lunch at Mt. Lemmon, and a tour of the Tucson Police Dept. crime lab. For September we will be organizing a drive to Flagstaff for the International Jaguar Festival. As soon as we get more information on the Concours, rally and other events at the IJF, we will send it out to you. People will be attending from all over and the cars will be fabulous. In October the British Wheels on the Green will be taking place near Phoenix. Again, we will share info as soon as we have it.

Some of you have been wondering what is happening with our 2023 Concours disqualification. I have been fighting this for a few months now and should obtain a final resolution mid-March. JCNA has stated that the reason for the disqualification is that the training for the judges was not held 30 days before our event. The 2023 rules clearly state that the training must be held 14 days prior to the event which is what we did. It seems that there was a misprint in the 2023 JCNA rules. In addition, we have found other clubs that did not follow the rule but were not disqualified. Anyway, stay tuned and I will let all know the final outcome.

As some of you noticed, the JCSA Board decided at our last meeting to change the date of our Concours. There were several reasons but the main reason was that the required annual judge's training must take place at least 30 days prior to the Concours. Most of our snowbirds do not return to Tucson until mid-October which would push our Concours till almost Thanksgiving. Additionally, we did not want to have two major events, Concours/awards dinner and holiday party, in consecutive months. JCSA's next Concours will be April 5, 2025, at La Encantada. The mall has already agreed to the date.

Our members' club and JCNA membership have been renewed for the calendar year. We did lose about 6 members, but since the new year we have gained a few new folks. We welcome them and hope they will join us in our first Wednesday dinners and other events. Speaking of first Wednesday dinners, we are still looking for other restaurant options. Please email me any ideas that you may have. I think during the summer months (June-Sept) we will try out Bazil's Italian Restaurant. We will let everyone know ahead of time to make sure there is no confusion.


