The Jaguar Daimler Heritage Trust was established in 1963. A team of employees, trustees and volunteers work together to bring the legend to life and share the life story of Jaguar and its predecessor companies. The website provides in-depth views of the Vehicle Collection, Artwork Collection, Exhibitions, History and Engineering of six brands, and a description of the Archives.

The Trust was established to maintain and promote for the benefit of the nation, the permanent preservation of historic archives, artefacts and motor vehicles manufactured and sold by Jaguar Cars Ltd. (now renamed Jaguar Land Rover Ltd.) and its predecessor companies under the marque names of Swallow, SS, Jaguar, Daimler and Lanchester, where such vehicles are of actual potential historic, scientific importance and educational value.

Two main permanent display locations are the British Motor Museum in Gaydon, Warwickshire, and the Coventry Transport Museum, both open to the public.

Moss Classic Jaguar Introduces Replacement Timing Cover for Jaguar Six-Cylinder Engines

Moss Classic Jaguar is pleased to introduce a replacement timing cover for Jaguar 3.4-, 3.8- and 4.2-liter six-cylinder engines built from 1956 to 1987. Most original covers are now so highly corroded that repairs – if possible – require specialist welding and machining that far exceed the cost of the Classic Gold replacement. Per original specifications, the new Classic Gold timing cover is a high-pressure die casting and not an inferior sand casting like other reproductions.

The Classic Gold timing cover is a hybrid that accommodates early and late water pumps from 1956 to 1987. However, it does *not* fit XK120; XK140 before Engine G.1907; MK VII A-Series engines; MK VII B-Series engines or MK VII Engine D.1001 to D.6722. Studs, gaskets, and other mounting hardware are available separately. Note that the part requires final "decking" to ensure it is coplanar with the engine block. An installation tips sheet is available.

Moss part number 861-411 replaces Jaguar factory numbers C8614, C8614/1, C28480 and EAC2061 and retails for \$299.99. Contact Moss Motors at 800-444-5247 or visit www.mossmotors.com.

Jaguar Could Be Looking To China For Help On Its Next EV

It's being reported that Jaguar is planning on investing further in a partnership with Chinese automaker Chery to utilize its hybrid and battery-electric technology to create models in the near future. JLR and Chery have a partnership that goes back to 2012 when the two companies embarked on a 50/50 joint venture that saw the British brand grab a necessary foothold in the biggest automotive market in the world with models like an extended wheelbase XF.


