

Jaguar Is Changing Its Iconic Logo

The luxury automaker is replacing its former logo with a new one that is supposed to be a "powerful celebration of modernism." It's also a little less of the American "Jag-wahr," and a bit more of the traditional "Jag-you-are," as it's said across the pond.

Other changes to Jaguar's branding include a redesigned pouncing cat logo, called the Leaper. The Leaper, which has adorned its cars for several decades, is being eliminated in favor of the badge.

Jaguar Reveals First Concept Car

British luxury automaker Jaguar has revealed its Type 00 concept car, the first glimpse of a new electric vehicle following a controversial rebrand that has divided opinion. The Type 00 has a long bonnet and a fastback profile, as well as 23-inch alloy wheels. It is presented in two colors: Miami Pink and London Blue. While the Type 00 is a concept and will therefore never enter production, it has divided opinion online.

Jaguar Teases an EV Sedan

Jaguar's plans for its reinvention are still somewhat shrouded in mystery, but we now know that its ascension to the ultimate luxury realm—or at least the attempt at such a rise—will begin with the introduction of a new, electric four-door grand tourer. Jaguar released images of a camouflaged prototype undergoing testing on U.K. roads, and from those, we can see the luxury electric sedan will be of the full-size variety. It also features a very long hood and a steeply raked windshield. A recent U.S. trademark application suggests the name I-Type, which makes sense given Jaguar's first EV effort wore the name I-Pace.

Jaguar's Rebrand Has An Even Tougher Foe

In an interview with Jaguar's managing director, Rawdon Glove, discusses international markets. Turns out, Jaguar has ideas about China. "As part of our strategy, we will be present in fewer markets, but we will want to really concentrate our efforts in those markets that are going to be super important for us," Glover said. "And China, you can't ignore the largest automotive market in the world, the largest luxury market in the world. And so that's going to be going to be key for us as well."


